Preserve

Union Terminal is a Cincinnati icon. A national historic landmark. A local treasure. Union Terminal belongs to the people of this community and must be preserved. Cincinnati's Union Terminal is a National Historic Landmark and was recently named the 45th most important building in America by the American Institute of Architects.

Protect

Issue 6 is Union Terminal's life support. By renewing this levy, you provide critical funding for this iconic landmark.

Union Terminal, as home to Cincinnati Museum Center, is a key regional and national destination. *Forbes Traveler* ranked Cincinnati Museum Center as the 17th most visited museum in the nation—and the only museum in Ohio to make the list.

Cincinnati Museum Center and Union Terminal welcomes 1.3 million visitors annually, bringing \$15 million in new money to the region and helping to support 1,100 jobs.

Reduce

Issue 6, the Union Terminal levy renewal, will reduce your taxes.

The renewal will cost just 37 cents per month - \$4.44 per year - for the owner of a \$100,000 home. That is less than half of what homeowners have contributed to Union Terminal in the past.

At the reduced level, the levy will generate \$16.2 million over five years for the preservation and protection of Union Terminal.
